



Top 10 Reasons Why

MICHIGAN IS AUTOMOBILITY

- ✓ More than **2,200** facilities conduct automotive research, design, engineering, testing and validation in the state of Michigan.
- ✓ Michigan is home to **96 of the top 100** suppliers to North America.
- ✓ Since 2009, Michigan has received **\$29 billion** in OEM and supplier investment, more than three times any other state.
- ✓ More than **\$12 billion** is spent on automotive R&D annually – 72 percent of the U.S. total.
- ✓ Michigan **leads the nation** in the number of legislation passed and USDOT funded projects for connected and automated vehicle testing.

- ✔ More than **113,000 engineers** are employed and driving innovation in Michigan.
- ✔ Michigan workers manufactured nearly **1.8 million vehicles across 22 models**, accounting for 17 percent of all U.S. production.
- ✔ The Great Lakes State is **first in mobility-related patents** (data processing, vehicles, navigation, relative location) with 2,583 patents awarded over the past five years.
- ✔ Over the past five years, automotive-related jobs grew by **11.3 percent** and are expected to grow another 3 percent by 2022.
- ✔ Michigan is home to the **American Center for Mobility** – the world's first self-driving highway test facility.
